

# YOU LOSE, YOU WASH

## Game Rules

### Setup

Place the card on a flat surface. Build a Supply of 20 coins : 5 cents coins, 2 cents coins and 1 cent coins. This latter embodies dirty dishes. Place a 5 cents coin (tails up) on the card.

### How to Play

Players perform their turn one after the other. On his turn, a player chooses a coin from the Supply and puts it in balance (tails up) on the top coin of the Stack. You cannot cover the value of the previous coin. If the dishes' Stack don't move, the other player performs his turn.

A player can choose to place a coin heads up. He can cover the value of the previous coin but must rotate the card (a full turn) without the dishes falling. The following player could then place his coin without restriction, because the last placed coin is heads up.

### Victory Conditions & End of Play

The game ends when dishes collapse during any player's turn. The latter has lost. If there are dishes in the sink, he must immediately do the dishes. The other player is the winner. He can help the loser with a dish towel or get out the room, laughing at him.
