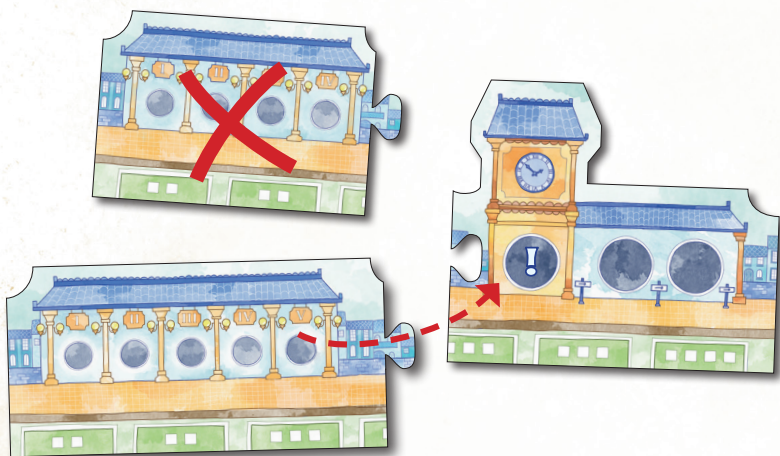


52 ADDITIONAL PAWNS

5-PLAYER GAME SETUP

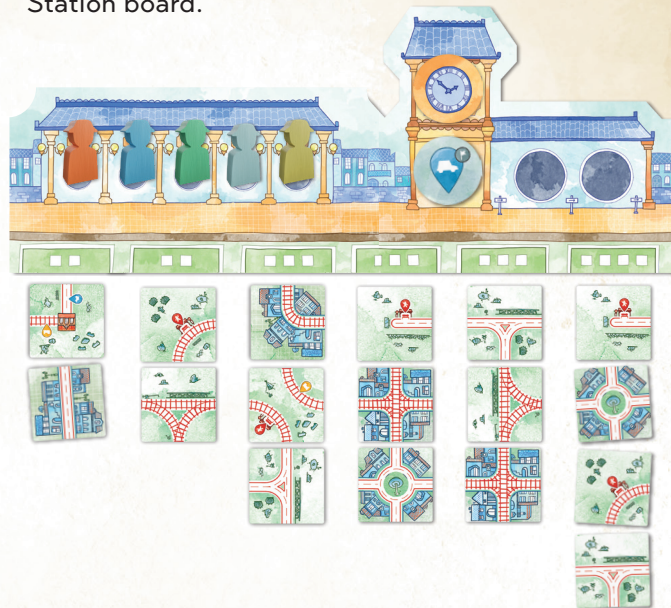
To set up a 5-player game of Railroad Tiles™, follow the changes to the regular setup procedure described below:

- 1 Add all additional pawns to the respective pools of pawns (you don't need to separate them afterwards to play 1–4-player games).
- 2 Add all additional Route tiles and Objective tiles to the respective sets; these are marked with a  in the top left corner, in case you want to remove them when playing 1–4-player games, but it is not necessary to do so.
- 3 When placing the Station board in the middle of the table in step 2 of the regular setup procedure, use the 5-player Station board piece instead of the regular left piece of the Station board. This includes a 5th space in the Turn Order Area as well as an additional column to place tiles in at the beginning of each round.

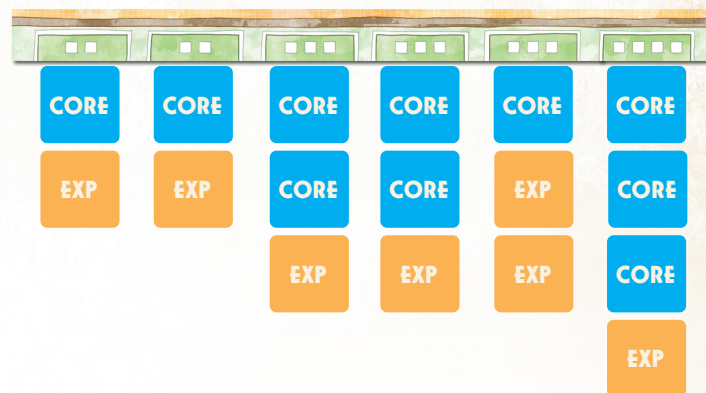


- 4 When taking Star pawns in step 8 of the regular setup procedure, each player takes 2 Star pawns instead of 1.

- 5 During Round Setup, reveal Route tiles from the cloth bag until you fill all the columns below the 5-player Station board.



If you are playing with an expansion, follow the special mix of tiles from the Core Game bag and the Expansion bag as shown below:



In all cases, each column must contain as many tiles as the number of square icons at the top of that column, as usual.
